KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that \_\_\_\_\_

as principal, and \_\_\_\_\_

as surety are held and firmly bound jointly and severally unto the Town of Seymour, CT, and the State of Connecticut, in the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars to be paid to the Town of Seymour and/or the State of Connecticut, for which payment well and truly to be made we hereby bind ourselves, or heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH THAT WHEREAS the Principal has made application to the Sewer Commission of the Town of Seymour for Registration to make openings and excavations in the public streets, highways, sidewalks, and alleys within the Town of Seymour under permits there for which may be issued from time-to-time by said Commission and whereas said Commission is prepared to issue such Registration to the Principal pursuant to Section 10A of the Town Code of the Town of Seymour.

Whereas said ordinance provides that qualified excavators and utility companies may in lieu of a cash deposit for each permit applied for, file with the Sewer Commission of the Town of Seymour an annual bond in the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.

Now therefore, if the said \_\_\_\_\_ shall well and truly keep and perform all the terms and conditions of the aforesaid ordinance as the same may be amended from time-to-time, any conditions set forth in the application filed pursuant thereto, and any conditions attaching to any permit issued pursuant to said ordinance and any applicable rules or regulations of the State Highway Department and shall forever indemnify and save harmless the Town of Seymour and the State of Connecticut and all their respective agents for or on account of any damage to any utilities furnished in the Town of Seymour in consequence of or resulting from any work performed by said principal \_\_\_\_\_ ITS servants or agents, or of, or from any negligence in awarding said work, or of, or from any act of omission of principal \_\_\_\_\_ ITS servants or agents until the expiration of the maintenance period; shall faithfully perform said work in all respects and shall also replace and restore that portion of any street in which said applicant, his servants or agents shall make any excavation, to as good condition as that in which the same was before said work was performed, and shall also keep and maintain such street in like good condition to the satisfaction of the Town's Agent for the period of not less than one year after completing said work, and should the Town's Agent or other official within said period, and after notice to said principal repair said portion of such street, the principal shall pay the cost thereof within thirty days and shall comply in all respects with the rules and regulations established by the Town's Agent relative to such work, and the terms of the permits that may be issued to him, and shall also pay all fines or penalties imposed upon him for violation of any such rule or regulations, then this bond shall be void but otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.
