1. Do not supply File No. in upper right corner as same refers to carrier's File No. in the Illinois Commerce Commission.
2. Three copies of this form (the original and two carbon copies) must be forwarded to the Illinois Commerce Commission. A fourth copy should be made for the Surety Company and, if required, a fifth copy should be forwarded to the Surety's agent.
3. Name and address of insured shall be typed in upper right corner and in the body of the Certificate, name to be given in full in both instances. Use of initials instead of full name is not permitted. In case a business style is used it should read "A B C Trucking Co., Doe, John Henry d/b/a."
4. This Certificate certifies that the Collect on Delivery Bond executed as Surety with the Principal is in form approved and required by the Illinois Commerce Commission, the same being Form III. C. C. 7-1-90.
