SURETY BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT _____
of _____ as Principal
and _____, surety company organized under the laws of
the State of _____ and licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, as Services in the total penal sum
of _____ dollars (_____) lawful money of the United States of America,
for which sum well and truly to be paid said Principal and Surety bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors
and assigns, jointly and severally firmly by these presents.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that regardless of the number of years this bond shall continue or be continued in force and of the
number of premiums which shall be payable or paid, the Surety shall not be liable thereunder for a larger amount, in the
aggregate, than the amount of this bond.

WHEREAS, the above named Principal is a nursing home as defined in 42 USCS 1396r, Kentucky Statutes, and, as such, is a
licensee under 42 USCS 1396r, requires each nursing home to post a surety bond, in an amount equal to one and one fourth
(1.25) the average monthly balance in the patient trust fund during the prior year of \$10,000.00 whichever is greater.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conditions of this obligation is such that if the above named Principal shall: (1) well and truly hold
separately and in trust all patients' funds deposited with Principal as a nursing home and (2) shall administer said funds on behalf
of said patients in the manner directed by 42 USCS 1396r, Kentucky Statutes, and (3) shall render true and complete accounts to
the patients, the depositors and the Obligee when requested, and (4) upon termination of each said deposit, shall account for all
funds received thereunder, expanded and held on hand.

This bond is executed and accepted subject to the following conditions: (1) The Department of Health and Rehabilitative
Services may maintain in his conditions hereof, in any court of competent jurisdiction in the Commonwealth of Kentucky (2)
This bond shall be effective as of 12:01 a.m. of _____, and shall continue in full force and effect until
_____. (3) Should the Surety so elect, this bond may be canceled by the Surety as to subsequent
liability by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing by certified mail to the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services.
