KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

That I (we) _____
as Principal, and _____
a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Tennessee in the penal sum of **TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS** (\$10,000), lawful money of the United States, for the payment of which sum well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these present.

The **CONDITION** of this obligation is that whereas Principal has filed an application for a certificate of registration as a fire extinguisher system firm under the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 32, Part 2:

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the issuance of such certificate of registration to the Principal herein, as provided in Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 32, Part 2, if the Principal shall pay to the extent of the face amount hereof all judgments which may be recovered against it to compensate third party losses caused by the wrongful acts or omissions of the Principal or the Principal's employees, servants, officers, or agents in the installation of service of portable fire extinguishers or fixed fire extinguisher systems, then this obligations shall be void; otherwise to remain in effect at all times and places in which the Principal engages in business as a fire extinguisher system firm in the State of Tennessee.

Any person who may be injured or aggrieved by a wrongful act or omission of the Principal or its employees, servants, officers, or agents shall have the right to sue directly on this bond without assignment thereof.

The TERM of this bond is continuous; provided, however, that the Surety shall have the right to cancel this bond at any time by a written notice stating when the cancellation shall take effect and served upon or sent by certified mail to the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, Division of Fire Prevention, 500 James Robertson Parkway, Third Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1159, at least thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of the cancellation; provided further that such cancellation shall not release the Surety from any liability existing hereunder at such effective date of cancellation.

In no event shall the aggregate liability of the Surety exceed the face amount hereof.
