The principle is required as a condition precedent to this appointment as a Modular Building Unit Installer to deliver annually to the obligee hereto a good and sufficient surety bond for the license period for protection of any person who suffers loss or damage resulting from code related non-compliances with the Tennessee Modular Building Act (Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 68-126-301 through 68-126-320) and the Rules (Chapter 0780-2-13) promulgated thereunder.

This bond may be terminated at any time by the Surety upon sending notice, in writing, by certified mail, to the Office of Tennessee State Fire Marshal and to the Principal, and at the expiration of thirty-five (35) days from mailing of said notice, this bond shall terminate and the Surety shall thereupon be relieved from any liability of any acts or omissions of the Principal subsequent to said date.
