

SURETY BOND

FITTING AND DISPENSING OF HEARING INSTRUMENTS SURETY BOND

This form is prescribed by the Texas Department of State Health Services on behalf of the State Committee of Examiners in the Fitting and Dispensing of Hearing Instruments.

BOND NUMBER:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, _____, as Principal, whose address is _____, and _____, a Surety, and

being a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Texas, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Texas, in the sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00), lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid by Obligee or its lawful representatives, or to judgment holders, for which payment, well and truly to be made, the Principal and Surety bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITIONS OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATIONS ARE SUCH THAT:

WHEREAS, the above bound Principal has or is about to obtain a license as a Fitter and Dispenser of Hearing Instruments in the State of Texas by the State Committee of Examiners in the Fitting and Dispensing of Hearing Instruments, and is required to provide this bond pursuant to Section 402.404 of the Texas Occupations Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that if the Principal shall pay all (1) taxes and contributions due to the State of Texas and its political subdivisions, and (2) judgments that the Principal may be required to pay for negligently or improperly dispensing hearing instruments or for breaching a contract relating to the dispensing of hearing instruments, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED, this bond may be cancelled as a future liability by the Surety upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Principal and the State Committee of Examiners in the Fitting and Dispensing of Hearing Instruments sent by regular mail. PROVIDED, FURTHER, the aggregate liability of the Surety to any and all persons, regardless of the number of claims made against the bond or the number of years the bond remains in force, shall in no event exceed the amount set forth above, nor shall it be cumulative.

This bond shall be effective on the _____ day of _____, _____, and shall be continuous until cancelled by action of the Surety, the Principal, or the State Committee of Examiners in the Fitting and Dispensing of Hearing Instruments. No person may commence an action on this bond later than the third anniversary of the date this bond was cancelled.
