KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we _____,
hereinafter called principal, and _____, hereinafter called surety,
are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the full and just sum of One thousand
Dollars (\$1000.00) lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said Commonwealth
of Virginia, its successors and assigns, to the payment whereof we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs,
executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally and firmly by these presents:

WHEREAS, the principal has his principal place of business outside the State of Virginia and/or
is a foreign corporation and desires to engage in the business of outdoor advertising in this State and has
made application for a license from the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner to grant him (it)
the right to do so, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 33.1-359 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, an out-of-State
licensee is required to furnish a bond guaranteeing that the said licensee (applicant) fulfill all
requirements of law as set out in Title 33.1, Chapter 7, Article 1, of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as
amended, and the regulations and orders of said Commissioner relating to the display of advertisements or
the erection of advertising structures issued pursuant thereto, and to indemnify the Commonwealth from
any damages caused by the breach of such law, orders or regulations on the part of the licensee
(applicant);

NOW, THEREFORE, the conditions of this obligation are such that, if the bounden principal shall in all respects comply with all requirements of law and the regulations and orders of the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner relating to the display of advertisements or the erection of advertising structures, and shall also comply with the terms and conditions of the license issued by the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner to said principal on the ____ day of _____, No. _____, and shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Virginia against and from all costs, expenses, damages, injury or loss to which said Commonwealth of Virginia may be subjected by reason of the failure of the said principal to fulfill all requirements of law and to obey and abide by all such orders and regulations as issued by the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner; then this obligation to be void; otherwise, to be and remain in full force and effect.
