

SURETY BOND

FOR DETECTIVE, PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR OR AGENCY LICENSE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we _____

Surety are held and firmly bound into the City of Dothan, Alabama, herein called "the City", in the sum of \$2,000.00 lawful money of the United States of America well and truly to be paid and for the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves, our successors and assigns jointly, severally, and in solido, firmly by these presents.

Whereas the said principal has applied to be licensed to engage in business as a **DETECTIVE, PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR OR AGENCY** for which a license from the City is required by the City Code.

The conditions of this bond are that the principal shall well and faithfully do and perform his work as a detective, private investigator or agency; shall fully comply with all of the ordinances, laws and regulations of the City with reference to his work as a detective, private investigator or agency; and shall indemnify anyone who may be wrongfully injured by the words or acts of said principal or his agents or employees in following the vocation, profession, business or calling as a detective, private investigator or agency. Said surety also agrees that the governing body shall be indemnified and saved harmless from all claims arising from accidents and damages of any character whatsoever, caused by the negligence of such principal or his agents or employees. Surety will pay on demand such sums up to its maximum liability.

Any person, firm or corporation injured in person or property by reason of any violation of said laws, ordinances or regulations by said principal or his agents or employees, or by any act, default or omission constituting a breach or any conditions of this bond, may maintain a suit or action hereon for such injury.

No license to engage in any such business shall be permanent until this bond is approved and filed with the City Clerk.

The surety shall have the right to cancel this bond upon written notice upon the City Clerk by registered mail to the City Clerk, P.O. Box 2128, Dothan, AL 36302, specifying therein the effective date of such cancellation. Such date shall not be less than 30 days after the date of service borne by sender's registry receipt. Provided, however, that the cancellation of this bond shall not relieve the principal or the surety herein from liability on said bond for default occurring prior to the date of said cancellation.
